



READING FUN

Have your kids earn points by doing extra chores so they can purchase these books on Amazon or at a local bookstore to keep for themselves.


Also, a great place to find books is your local thrift store or Goodwill.






CHARLOTTE'S WEB


THE PENDERWICKS

In this story, Josh McBroom gets a bargain on land that has soil so rich that seeds spring up into full-grown plants and even nickels grow into quarters in no time!




PAX
